

ASCA BOARD OF DIRECTORS – CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Presented by the ASCA Governance Committee



Timeline:

- July 14, 2021: Publish Call for Nominations
August 6, 2021: Deadline for candidates to submit nominations to Committee
August 25, 2021: Nominating Committee announces BoD Candidates
September 16, 2021: Election Day – Presentation of candidate video statements of no more than 3 min. each at ASCA Business Meeting (candidates are not required to be present)
September 17, 2021: BoD Meeting and Orientation for new and returning BoD members

Required Criteria:

- Must be an ASCA domestic member Coach at time of nomination and election.
- Directors must be/shall have been members of ASCA for three (3) years at the time of nomination.

Desired Criteria:

- Have previously attended an ASCA World Clinic or ASCA-run event.
- Have a minimum of ten (10) years of coaching experience.
- If a member of USA Swimming, must be a member in good standing (unblemished record) and have clean record with Center for Safe Sport.

Expectations:

- Attend 1-2 “in person” meetings per year.
- Attend Monthly zoom meetings.
- Participate in calls, subcommittees, and other ASCA BoD assignments.
- Attend ASCA World Clinic (ASCA will waive your registration fee).
- Contribute a “Talk” at an ASCA event each year (virtual or in-person, i.e. Doc Talk, World Clinic, etc.).
- Serve a term of three years.

To Apply:

Submit a brief written statement of intent of candidacy to governancecommittee@swimmingcoach.org by **August 6, 2021 deadline**. This statement should include:

- a. The candidate’s vision for tenure on the ASCA board.
- b. An explanation of the candidate’s track record of involvement with the sport. For example; governance, LSC involvement, USA Swimming involvement, fiscal oversight, club/team management and administration, strategic planning, etc.

Candidates who are placed on ballot will be asked to send in a video statement of no more than 3 minutes which will be played at the ASCA business meeting on September 16, 2021 prior to voting.
